1.	<b>Who is eligible for All India Quota Counseling?</b>	The candidates who have been placed in Merit List/ Eligible for Wait List in AIPVT-2016 result on the basis of their score in All India Pre-Veterinary Test (AIPVT)-2016 conducted by the Veterinary Council of India on 14 <sup>th</sup> May, 2016. Candidates may download the Result from the Council's website. Cutoff marks of candidates who have been placed in Merit List/ Eligible for Wait List is given in the Result declared on 20 <sup>th</sup> June, 2016.
2.	<b>What is All India Rank (AIR)?</b>	All India Rank (AIR) is over all All India Rank based on AIPVT-2016 Score on all India basis.
3.	<b>What is Category Rank?</b>	Category Rank is over all All India Category Rank on all India basis based on AIPVT-2016 Score and Category filled up by the candidate in the Application Form.
4.	<b>What are the steps involved in the Counseling process?</b>	<p>The allotment of Seats shall be made through <b>ONLINE and ONSPOT counseling</b> as follows :</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>1st and 2nd Round - Through online</b></li> <li>• <b>3rd Round - OnSpot by Personal Appearance</b></li> </ul> <p><b>The following steps are involved in the Counseling process:</b></p> <p><b>Registration of Candidates for Counseling :</b> (Only by those placed in Merit/ eligible for Wait List)</p> <p>Candidates have to first register themselves for participating in AIPVT-2016 counseling in the Council's website. The registration can be done by entering requisite information like Candidate's Name, Mother' Name, date of birth, roll number, application number etc.</p> <p><b>Candidates who are registered shall only be considered for counseling for admission to B.V.Sc. &amp; A.H. course under 15% All India Quota.</b></p> <p><b>Round-1 through online:</b> During round 1 of AIPVT 2016 counseling, only the registered candidates have the option of choice filling and locking. Choices for colleges opted will be processed for allotment of seats. Steps involved shall be as follows:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. Filling of Choices for colleges, alteration of choices and Locking of choices</li> <li>b. Allotment of Seats based on rank and choices filled in Round 1</li> <li>c. Publication of Result-Round 1</li> <li>d. Reporting at the allotted College against Round 1</li> </ol> <p><b>Candidates who shall not report after seat allotment in round 1 at allotted colleges shall not be eligible for counseling in further rounds.</b></p> <p><b>Round-2 through online:</b> During round 2 of counseling, only the registered candidates have the option to change/alter their choices as selected in round 1 and can also submit new choices. Choices for colleges opted will be processed for allotment of seats. <b>In round 2 there will be no new registration.</b> Steps involved shall be as follows:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. Exercising of Additional Choice Filling, Choice Alteration and Locking</li> <li>b. Allotment of Seats based on rank and choices filled in Round 2</li> <li>c. Publication of Result-Round 2</li> <li>d. Reporting at the allotted College against Round 2</li> </ol> <p><b>Candidates who shall not report after seat allotment in round 2 at allotted colleges shall not be eligible for counseling in further rounds.</b></p> <p><b>Round-3 ONSPOT BY PERSONAL APPEARANCE :</b> During round 3 of counseling, only the registered candidates shall be considered for onspot counseling. <b>The venue and detail schedule of onspot counseling by personal appearance shall be displayed at Council's website after completion of 2nd round of online counseling.</b></p> <p><b>Please note that Registration facility will be available only before start of Round-1 on date as given in counseling Schedule. Candidates cannot register after closing date of Registration.</b></p>

5.	<b>When will allotment process for the current year start?</b>	Allotment process will start as per counseling schedule available on Council's website.
6.	<b>What is the date for commencement of academic session for current year?</b>	For detail of commencement of academic session for current year, the college authorities may be contacted by the candidate.
7.	<b>Do I have to report to any counseling centre for registration or choice filling?</b>	No. Online registration and choice filling can be done from place of convenience (including from home) using internet on Council's website.
8.	<b>Do I require any documents to get registered on-line?</b>	The registration can be done by entering requisite information like Candidate's Name, Mother's Name, date of birth, roll number, application number etc. as given in Confirmation Page/ Admit Card. <b>IMPORTANT:</b> <b>Please keep Confirmation Page/ Admit Card ready and keep it confidential, and do not share with anybody as requisite information shall be required to register for online allotment process and submit choices. If somebody else knows that information, he/she can misuse your online registration and prevent you from taking part in online allotment process.</b>
9.	<b>What information do I require for online registration?</b>	You will be required to fill requisite information like Candidate's Name, Mother's Name, date of birth, roll number, application number etc. given in your Confirmation Page/ Admit Card, therefore, keep copy of your Confirmation Page/ Admit Card ready for reference. <b>IMPORTANT:</b> <b>Please note that for registration, you have to fill in requisite information exactly same spelling, numbers etc. as given in your Confirmation Page/ Admit Card.</b>
10.	<b>How do I get password for logging in?</b>	During the process of online registration you will generate password as per password policy, which will be shown to you when you register and create password. <b>You can change the password after creating.</b> Password is very important for participating in online allotment process. Sharing of password can result in its misuse by somebody else, leading to even exclusion of genuine candidate from online allotment process. Please also note and remember your password till end of All India Quota admission process; otherwise you will not be able to participate in counseling/admission process. <b>IMPORTANT:</b> <b>Candidates are advised to keep the password that they have created confidential till the end of the counseling/admission process.</b>
11.	<b>How much time will I be given to join the allotted college?</b>	The candidates allotted seats will be required to join the allotted college within stipulated time given in counseling schedule. The candidate is advised to report and join the allotted College as early as possible but not later than the stipulated period, as mentioned in counseling schedule, failing which the allotted seat will be cancelled and the candidate will not be eligible to participate in subsequent rounds of counseling. In some of the allotted Colleges, 2-3 days time is required to complete admission formalities. Please also take into consideration holiday(s)/local holiday(s). The candidates are further advised to contact the allotted college authorities for details before proceeding for admission. The detail of College authorities to whom to be contacted by the candidate is given on Council's website under heading " <b>College Details</b> ". <b>The candidates, who fail to report/join the allotted college by the last date of reporting / joining, shall forfeit his/her claim for a seat under 15% All India Quota. No extension of reporting/joining time will be allowed by the Council under any circumstances.</b>
12.	<b>What documents are required at the time of online counseling?</b>	No documents are required for participating in online allotment process.
13.	<b>What documents are required at the time of joining/ admission in allotted college?</b>  <b>and</b>  <b>What documents are required</b>	The candidates allotted seats should produce the following documents <b>in original</b> along with self attested copy of the documents for verification at the time of reporting/ admission at the allotted college and at the VCI office during onspot counseling <b>failing which they shall not be entitled for admission at the allotted College and onspot counseling.</b>  <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Confirmation Page (<b>OR</b>) Admit Card downloaded from Council's website.</li> <li>➤ AIPVT-2016 Result downloaded from Council's website.</li> </ul>

<p><b>at the time of onspot counseling?</b></p>		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Proof of Admission in the College (Fee receipt by those who have been allotted seats during Ist/2nd round of counseling during onspot counseling)</li> <li>➤ Date of Birth Certificate (if Secondary School Examination Certificate does not have the same)</li> <li>➤ Secondary School Examination or equivalent Certificate</li> <li>➤ 10+2 Mark Sheet (Qualifying Examination Mark Sheet)</li> <li>➤ 10+2 Certificate or Provisional Certificate (Qualifying Examination Certificate). <b>Provisional certificate is permissible for those candidates who had passed in the year 2016 only.</b></li> <li>➤ Character Certificate from the School or College last attended,</li> <li>➤ Proof of identity (Voter ID Card/Aadhar Card/ID Card of College or School)</li> <li>➤ Four passport size coloured Photographs (<b>same as uploaded on the Online Application Form</b>) and One Postcard size coloured Photographs (<b>same as uploaded on the Online Application Form</b>).</li> </ul> <p>The Candidate should also produce the following certificate (in the standard format issued by the competent authority and should be in English or Hindi only) in original, if applicable, at the allotted College at the time of reporting/admission and at the VCI office during onspot counseling:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) SC/ST Certificate as per format given in <b>Appendix-I</b>. Sub caste should be clearly mentioned in the certificate.</li> <li>(ii) OBC Certificate as per format given in <b>Appendix-II</b>. The sub-caste should tally with the Central List of OBC. The OBC candidates <b>should not belong to Creamy Layer to claim OBC reservation benefit.</b></li> <li>(iii) Locomotor Disability Certificate as per format given in <b>Appendix-III</b>. The disability should be certified by a duly constituted and authorised Medical Board comprising of atleast three specialists out of which two should be of the speciality concerned and the candidate has to present him/her – self before the Medical Board. The last valid disability certificate of the candidate from a Medical Board should not be more than three months old from the date of submitting.</li> <li>(iv) The candidates from Jammu &amp; Kashmir who have uploaded Self Declaration claiming their eligibility under 15% All India Quota shall have to submit an affidavit as per <b>Appendix-IV</b> on Non Judicial Stamp Paper of Rs.10/- duly attested by Metropolitan Magistrate/ First Class Judicial Magistrate.</li> </ul>
<p><b>14. What are the instructions regarding OBC, SC/ST and PH certificates?</b></p>		<p>Instructions are given at <b>Point 4 under ELIGIBILITY and Point 5 under ADMISSION AND RESERVATION</b> in Information Bulletin for AIPVT-2016 admission.</p>
<p><b>15. From where can I obtain Physical Handicap/ Disability (PH) Certificate?</b></p>		<p>The Physically Handicapped/Disability (PH) certificate should be obtained as per format given in <b>Appendix-III</b> (in the standard format) from a Disability Assessment Board in a Government Hospital authorized to issue Locomotor Disability Certificate.</p> <p>The Physically Handicapped/Disable (PH) candidates are required to carry their treatment papers related to their disability, including the investigation reports, at the time of reporting to the Disability Assessment Board in the Government Hospital for issuance of the Locomotor Disability Certificate.</p>
<p><b>16. What are the details of disability for claiming advantage under PH category?</b></p>		<p>Instructions are given at <b>Point 4 under Physical Disability</b> in Information Bulletin for AIPVT-2016 admission.</p>
<p><b>17. Is there any restriction for filling up number of choices of College in choice filling form?</b></p>		<p>No, you can give as many choices as you wish during online choice filling. <b>However, choices should be in order of candidates' preference.</b></p>
<p><b>18. Is it necessary to fill up the choices and lock the choices to get seat allotted? Or I will be allotted seat automatically from leftover seats?</b></p>		<p>Candidates have to first register themselves for participating in AIPVT-2016 counseling in the Council's website. <b>Candidates who are not registered shall not be considered for counseling for admission to B.V.Sc. &amp; A.H. course under 15% All India Quota.</b></p> <p>Yes, it is necessary to lock the choices. If candidate does not lock the choices submitted by him/her, it will be automatically locked on last date of choice locking given in the Counseling Schedule.</p> <p>You have to fill up the choice of colleges in order of your preference. While</p>

		<p>exercising choices for colleges, candidate can interchange their opted choices number of times. But once the choice is locked and saved by candidates they cannot be either changed or unlocked. Once the choice is locked by candidates, the list of selected colleges as per choice will appear on the screen for printing. <b>If you don't fill up choices, you will not be allotted seats.</b></p> <p><b>IMPORTANT :</b>  <b>If you don't register and fill up choices during registration period, you will not be allotted seat. Please also note that registration can only be done before allotment of round -1, during period specified in Counseling Schedule.</b>  <b>Don't wait till the last minute to Register and Lock your choices and to take a printout. Please go through your submitted choices before locking, as once you lock the choices they cannot be modified or changed even if you have made a mistake. It may result in allotment of a seat which you never wanted.</b></p>
19.	<b>Is it necessary to join allotted College to get chance to participate in next round (2nd/3rd round)?</b>	Yes, candidates are required to join allotted college and complete the admission formalities then only candidate can exercise option to participate in next round(s) at allotted college, during admission process.
20.	<b>If seats in a College are increased/ decreased (OR) Names of Colleges are added/ deleted after start of online counseling, when these will be included?</b>	<p>If seats in a College are increased/decreased or Names of Colleges are added/ deleted that could not be included in round 1 due to non-reporting / late reporting/ reporting after start of round 1 of online allotment process, will be included in round 2 on receiving information from participating Colleges before the start of round 2 (publication of the seat matrix).</p> <p>Similarly, if seats in a College are increased/decreased or Names of Colleges are added/ deleted that could not be included in round 2 due to non-reporting / late reporting/ reporting after start of round 2 of online allotment process, will be included in round 3 on receiving information from participating Colleges before the start of round 3(publication of the seat matrix).</p>
21.	<b>Who is eligible for Ist Round of allotment?</b>	During round 1 of counseling, only the registered candidates have the option of choice filling and locking. Choices for colleges opted will be processed for allotment of seats in round 1. <b>If you don't fill up choices, you will not be allotted seats.</b>
	<b>Who is not eligible for Ist Round of allotment?</b>	Candidates who did not register themselves for AIPVT 2016 counseling during registration process on the Council's website.
22.	<b>Who is eligible for 2nd Round of allotment?</b>	<p>During round 2 of counseling, only the registered candidates have the option to change/alter their choices as selected in round 1 and can also submit new choices (if not changed, earlier choices submitted will be taken as final) Choices for colleges opted will be processed for allotment of seats in round 2. <b>In round 2 there will be no new registration.</b></p> <p><b>Following candidates shall be eligible for Round 2 Counseling:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Registered candidates who did not get any seat in the AIPVT 2016 counseling in round 1 as per choices filled up</li> <li>Candidates who were allotted seat in round 1 and have reported/ joined the college and gave option for change of college in round 2</li> <li>Candidates who were allotted seat in round 1 and have reported the college for admission. However, allotted Seat Cancelled during the document verification on reporting for admission due to change of Category from reserved to Unreserved or PH status from Yes to No, will be considered for allotment of seat in the next round of seat allotment, with changed Category, subject to availability of seat in respective category.</li> </ul>
	<b>Who is not eligible for 2nd Round of allotment?</b>	<p><b>Following candidates shall not be eligible for Round 2 Counseling:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Candidates who did not register themselves for AIPVT 2016 counseling during registration process on the Council's website.</li> <li>Candidates who did not report at allotted Veterinary colleges after seat allotment in round 1</li> <li>Reported for admission &amp; then withdrawn / resigned allotted college in round 1</li> <li>Candidates who have not opted for change of college during round-2.</li> </ul>
23.	<b>What is Round-3 Onspot counseling by Personal Appearance?</b>	<p>In round 3, the allotment of Seats shall be made through <b>OnSpot by Personal Appearance of the candidates.</b></p> <p>Date wise Candidate's details and venue for OnSpot Counseling by Personal Appearance shall be displayed on the Council's website after completion of 2nd round of online counseling.</p>
24.	<b>What is the procedure for</b>	In round 3, <b>the personal appearance of candidate shall be required for</b>

	<b>Round-3 of onspot counseling by Personal Appearance?</b>	<p><b>counseling on the date and venue of counseling displayed on the Council's website after completion of 2nd round of online counseling.</b></p> <p>The allotment of seat shall be made on the basis of seniority in merit and subject to availability of seats in a particular Veterinary College at the time and date of allotment. <b>Allotment shall be closed immediately after the seats reserved for the purpose are filled.</b></p> <p>The College/Category wise number of seats available for Round 3 shall be made available on Council's website.  <b>All the seats remaining vacant after the process of allotment of 3rd round of counseling or falling vacant thereafter due to any reasons shall be filled up by the State.</b></p>
25.	<b>Who is eligible for round 3 of counseling?</b>	<p>During the round 3 of counseling, only the registered candidates shall be considered for onspot counseling. <b>In round 3 there will be no new registration.</b></p> <p><b>Following candidates shall be eligible for Round 3 Counseling:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Registered candidates who did not get any seat in the AIPVT 2016 counseling in round 1 or round 2 as per choices filled up</li> <li>Candidates who were allotted seat in round 2 and have reported/ joined the college and gave option for change of college in round 3.</li> <li>Candidates who were allotted seat in round 2 and have reported the college for admission. However, allotted Seat Cancelled during the document verification on reporting for admission due to change of Category from reserved to Unreserved or PH status from Yes to No, will be considered for allotment of seat, with changed Category, subject to availability of seat in respective category.</li> </ul>
	<b>Who is not eligible for round 3 of counseling?</b>	<p><b>Following candidates shall not be eligible for Round 3 Counseling:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Candidates who did not register themselves for AIPVT 2016 counseling during registration process on the Council's website.</li> <li>Candidates who did not report at allotted Veterinary colleges after seat allotment in round 2</li> <li>Reported for admission &amp; then withdrawn / resigned allotted college in round 2</li> <li>Candidates who have not opted for change of college during round-3.</li> </ul>
26.	<b>Can a candidate participate in round 3 without registering?</b>	No. Only the registered candidates shall be considered for onspot counseling. <b>In round 3 there will be no new registration.</b>
27.	<b>Do I have to fill in choice of College to participate in round 2 of online allotment process?</b>	Yes. During the round 2 of counseling, only the registered candidates have the option to change/alter their choices as selected in round 1 and can also submit new choices (if not changed, earlier choices submitted will be taken as final). Choices for colleges opted will be processed for allotment of seats in round 2. <b>In round 2 there will be no new registration.</b>
28.	<b>Do I have to fill in choice of College to participate in round 3 of onspot counseling?</b>	No. <b>Candidates who have registered only shall be considered for counseling.</b> The allotment of seat shall be made on the basis of seniority in merit and subject to availability of seats in a particular College at the time and date of allotment. <b>Allotment shall be closed immediately after the seats reserved for the purpose are filled.</b>
29.	<b>If I give consent for up-gradation of my choice during round 2 and if my choice is upgraded, is it necessary to join at college allotted during second round? Or In case I change my decision of upgrading choice, can I continue study in college allotted through round 1 of allotment?</b>	<p>In case candidate is allotted seat during round 2 of allotment process the seat allotted during the round 1 will be automatically cancelled immediately (and allotted to somebody else) and candidate will have to join the college allotted during round 2 after obtaining online generated relieving letter from college allotted in Round-1. If candidate does not join the college allotted during the round 2, within stipulated period, as per schedule, from the date of allotment, candidate will forfeit his/her allotted seat and will not be considered for subsequent rounds of seat allotment.</p> <p><b>Seat can also be up-graded in the same college by change of category (i.e. ST/SC/OBC to UR) in such a case also the candidate has to take fresh admission on the up-graded seat, as per procedure.</b></p> <p>The same procedure will apply for allotment in round-3.</p>
30.	<b>If I forget my password that I have created during the process of registration, how to retrieve it?</b>	<p><b>To retrieve the forgotten password, system facilitates the following process:</b></p> <p>The candidate is required to enter the information that he/she filled at the time of registration and then security question &amp; answer thereon to be entered as given during New Candidate registration process. The above data submitted by candidate will be validated with the registered candidates' database. If the above entries match, then only the candidate would be</p>

		permitted to enter new password to proceed further. <b>IMPORTANT</b> <b>Candidates are advised to remember the password, Security question &amp; its chosen answer and also retain their Confirmation Page/ Admit Card ready till completion of admission process. It is not possible for the VCI to retrieve such password.</b>
31.	In case I have Birth Certificate/Caste Certificate/ other certificate(s) in regional language, will it be acceptable at the time of reporting/ joining?	Certificates issued by the competent authority (in standard format), should be in English or Hindi language. Candidates are advised to carry certified (attested) Copy of English version of the original certificate, in case certificate issued is in other than English language, along with original certificate.
32.	If there is discrepancy in spelling of name in documents and application form, what do I do?	If there is discrepancy in spelling of name in documents, candidate must carry proof that the documents belongs to same person, in the form of an affidavit.
33.	Can I get Information Bulletin of AIPVT-2016 for admission to 15% of total seats on all-India basis?	Copy of Information Bulletin for AIPVT-2016 admission is available on Council's website.
34.	What about fee structure and location of various Colleges.	The College wise fee detail for current year is given on Council's website under heading " <b>College Details</b> ". However, for exact fee the college authorities may be contacted by the candidate.
35.	How to use registration and Choice filling form on website?	Candidates will have to log on to Council's website to get registered and then fill in choices. <b>Please read following carefully to understand the Counseling Process:-</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ <b>Counseling Schedule</b></li> <li>➤ <b>Flow chart showing process of AIPVT-2016 counseling</b></li> <li>➤ <b>User manual for the candidates</b></li> <li>➤ <b>Information Bulletin (Counseling)</b></li> <li>➤ <b>College/Category wise number of seats available at each round of counseling</b></li> <li>➤ <b>Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)</b></li> </ul> It is advised that after going through the list of seats available, a tentative list may be prepared first as per your preference of colleges, before attempting to fill choices on-line.
36.	Is there any Veterinary college which admits Girls only?	No. At present there is no Veterinary college which admits Girls only.
37.	Difficulty in login, what may be the problem(s)?	Please read User manual for the candidates. Follow the instructions about use of browser, use of same spellings, and same format of date (Use digits for day, month and year with - in between) as in Confirmation Page / Admit Card. The internet connection should be uninterrupted. If internet connection interruption takes place, the IP address which is being monitored by the Counseling Software, will change and session expired message will be displayed. In such case, please try to login from other computer having uninterrupted internet connection from which other candidate(s) has logged in successfully, if possible.
38.	I have difficulty in creating Password, what may be the problem(s)?	Creation of password should be as per password policy. Please follow the password policy. Please use the internet browser as suggested in user manual, as it is difficult to login from some of the other browsers. While creating password avoid using Caps Lock key, instead of Caps Lock key, use shift key.
39.	When I try to login for choice filling/ submission, it say wrong roll number/ password, what may be problem(s)?	This can happen if roll number typed is incorrect or password typed is incorrect. Password is case sensitive, therefore use password which was created by user exactly same as typed while creating. In case password is forgotten, try to retrieve password by using security question and its answer.
40.	What are the guidelines for fresh choice filling before round 3 of onspot allotment process?	<b>There shall be no fresh choice filling before Round 3 of OnSpot counseling by Personal Appearance.</b> During round 3 of counseling, only the registered candidates shall be considered for onspot counseling. <b>In round 3 there will be no new registration.</b> <b>The venue and detail schedule of onspot counseling by personal appearance shall be displayed at Council's website after completion of 2nd round of online counseling.</b>
41.	Can I modify my choices	Yes, you can modify, add or delete your choices during this period, before you

	<b>during the period of “Exercising of Choices and Locking” (during round 1) and Fresh Choice submission and locking for round 2”.</b>	lock your choices. But once you lock your Choices then you can not modify. However, the registration of Candidates (New Users) is permitted up to specific date as mentioned in Counseling Schedule.
42.	<b>If I do not lock my choices up to the last date of locking, what will happen to my choices?</b>	<b>The choices submitted and saved</b> by you will be locked by the system on the last date of locking.
43.	<b>How can I get print out of my choices which system has locked?</b>	After last date of locking/ after locking of choices by the system, you will be able to take a printout of your submitted choices, during the first and second round of seat allotment and admission. You will also be able to see your locked choices and able to take a print out of the same at allotted College at the time of admission on request.
44.	<b>If I opt to participate in third round of counseling whether my allotted seat (of first/second round) will be cancelled?</b>	In case you are not allotted any seat in the third round, you will retain earlier allotted seat. However on allotment of a seat in third round, the earlier allotted seat will automatically be cancelled and allotted to another candidate.
45.	<b>If I get an up-graded seat during second/ third round, can I join that college directly?</b>	No, you will have to get <b>online generated relieving letter from the earlier college</b> (from VCC software - will be given by the college authority), before you join the next college. Without such relieving letter candidate will not be permitted to join the seat allotted in round-2/round-3.
46.	<b>In case I get an upgraded seat but in the same college, because of change of category, (e.g. from SC or ST to UR category) do I have to take admission on the allotted seat again?</b>	Yes, you have to get a relieving letter generated on-line for the earlier seat and then get an admission letter again generated on-line for the upgraded category seat from the concerned college; otherwise your seat will be cancelled and allotted to another candidate or shifted to state quota (in case of third round).
