## PUBLIC NOTICE -VCI - COUNSELING – 2017

### SCHEDULE FOR ALLOCATION OF REMAINING VACANT SEATS TO B.V.Sc. & A.H. DEGREE COURSE UNDER 15% ALL INDIA QUOTA DURING 2017-18

This is in continuation to the Public Notice dated 11.9.2017 and 13.9.2017 regarding schedule for counseling for filling up of 15% seats to B.V.Sc. & A.H. Degree course on All India basis during 2017-18. It is informed that allocation of 15% seats (434 seats) for admission to B.V.Sc. & A.H. Degree Course in the recognized Veterinary Colleges under All India quota has been done and the selected candidates were advised to report for admission to the allotted Colleges upto 25.9.2017 (4.00 P.M).

Now, the Department of Animal Husbandry, Dairying and Fisheries, Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare, Government of India vide its letter No. K-12052-6/1/2017-LH(Part (1) dated 25.09.2017 has accorded permission for further round of allocation of vacant seats, if any, remaining vacant after 25.9.2017 (4.00 P.M). Accordingly, schedule for allocation for remaining vacant seats from the next eligible registered candidates for VCI- Counseling – 2017 is as under :-
